The Law of POLARITY (Mutable)

“Everything is Dual; everything has poles; everything has its pair of opposites; like and unlike are the same; opposites are identical in nature, but different in degree; extremes meet; all truths are but half-truths; all paradoxes may be reconciled.” – *The Kybalion*

(SEVEN articles on how to be in **HARMONY** with the Will-of-GOD and the Universe)

How does this FOURTH of the seven Universal Laws unfolds? This Law explains the old paradoxes, that have perplexed so many, which have been stated as follows: “Thesis and antithesis are identical in nature, but different in degree”; “opposites are the same, differing only in degree”; “the pairs of opposites may be reconciled”; “extremes meet”; “everything is and isn’t, at the same time”; “all truths are but half truths”; “every truth is half false”; “there are two sides to everything,” etc., etc., etc. It explains that in everything there are two poles, or opposite aspects, and that “opposites” are really only the two extremes of the same thing, with many varying degrees between them. It is the first of the Mutable or transcendable Universal Laws.

An illustration: Heat and Cold, although “opposites,” are really the same thing, the differences consisting merely of degrees of the same thing. Look at your thermometer and see if you can discover where “heat” terminates and “cold” begins! There is no such thing as “absolute heat” or “absolute cold”—the two terms “heat” and “cold” simply indicate varying degrees of the same thing, and that “same thing” which manifests as “heat” and “cold” is merely a form, variety, and rate of Vibration. So “heat” and “cold” are simply the “two poles” of that which we call “Heat”. The same Law manifests in the case of “Light and Darkness,” which are the same thing, the difference consisting of varying degrees between the two poles of the phenomena. Where does “darkness” leave off, and “light” begin?

Realistically, what is the difference between “Large and Small”? Between “Hard and Soft”? Between “Black and White”? Between “Sharp and Dull”? Between “Noise and Quiet”? Between “High and Low”? Between “Positive and Negative”? The Law of Polarity explains these paradoxes, and no other Law can supersede it. The same Law operates on the Mental Plane. Let us take a radical and extreme example—that of “Love and Hate,” two mental states apparently totally different. And yet there are degrees of Hate and degrees of Love, and a middle point in which we use the terms “Like or Dislike,” which shade into each other so gradually that sometimes we are at a loss to know whether we “like” or “dislike” or “neither.” And all are simply degrees of the same thing, as you will see if you will but think a moment.

More critical, it is possible to change the vibrations of Hate to the vibrations of Love, in one’s own mind, and in the minds of others. Many of you, who read these lines, have had personal experiences of the involuntary rapid transition from Love to Hate, and the reverse, in your own case and that of others. And you will therefore realize the possibility of this being accomplished by the use of the Will. “Good and Evil” are but the poles of the same thing, and to understand the art of transmuting Evil into Good is a vital art of Life. In short, the “Art of Polarization” becomes a phase of “Mental Alchemy”. An understanding of the Law will enable one to change his or her own Polarity, as well as that of others, if he or she will devote the time and study necessary to master the art.

On all occasions, you can transmute your emotions along the same line of any pair of opposites by rising above your emotions and by consciously choosing to focus on higher emotions. This serves to raise your Mental Plane’s overall vibration and hence also your corresponding. This Law may appear to be very real in your LIFE but it operates only in the Physical and Mental Planes, not in the Spiritual Plane where ALL IS ONE. By always placing the All-Powerful, All-Knowing Great Spirit or Absolute of which your true self is a Divine Spark, behind everything you say and do, and by endeavoring to focus on the positive even when things appear not to be going your way, while also avoiding the extremes, then in time, you will come to master this Law of Polarity.

Never allow yourself to make impulsive decisions or become overly judgemental. On the contrary, seek to “suspend your judgement”. By refusing to label anything as ‘good’ or ‘bad’ be it a desire, person, thought, thing or circumstance, you prevent yourself from becoming attached to either side. And when you are not attached to either side of the opposites, you can see them for what they are – different expressions of the same thing; and so you can start to transcend this Law of Polarity. Moreover, we can transform undesirable thoughts by concentrating on the opposite pole. One positive way of transforming negative thoughts is to write them down and then burn the piece of paper. Then write down what you do want so as to attract that into your LIFE instead.

Yearningly, it is the way you deeply feel that matters a lot. Feel like Christ and you will be a Christ; feel like Buddha and you will be a Buddha. It is feeling that is the LIFE, the strength, the vitality, without which no amount of intellectual activity can reach God. Referring to the psychological provenance of “the idea of the Holy Ghost,” Jung said: “Out of the tension of duality life always produces a ‘third’ that seems somehow incommensurable or paradoxical.” Don’t play the blame game. condemn none. If you can stretch out a helping hand, do so. If you cannot, fold your hands, bless your brothers, and let them go their own way. The greatest RELIGION is to be true to your own nature. Have faith in yourself!
